

COMMON LANGUAGE<sup>®</sup> Customer Service Bulletin NEP-5-1-2009

Please be advised of the following changes to the Common Language CLEI InQuery System, which will be available in Release 7.2 effective May 11, 2009.

These changes are summarized as follows:

- ❖ English/Metric Conversion: When any English (i.e., Imperial) or equivalent Metric values are entered by the user into CLEI InQuery and the user specifies the Unit of Measure, the system will immediately convert any newly-entered English measure field(s) to the corresponding Metric measure field(s) (and vice versa), as long as the corresponding field is not already populated.
- ❖ Assignment Code Status: Within the Equipment database each Assignment Code (a.k.a Logical Code) now has a Status field and can support a value of either 'A' for active or 'I' for Inactive. Assignment codes in an Active status will be included in the Hardwired Reference data screen, which will also display this status field for all Assignment codes accordingly.
- ❖ Reordering of Navigation Buttons: The forward and back buttons on this screen were rearranged to provide a more logical grouping.
- ❖ Configuration of the Number of Records Displayed per Page: The default number of records displayed per screen for CLEI InQuery had a default value of five this was increased to twenty. The user may update this value, but once Clear is selected the default number of records displayed will revert back to 20.
- ❖ Miscellaneous Enhancements: Field validations within CLEI InQuery were made consistent with the Equipment database constraints. Detailed explanations are provided within the CLEI InQuery for various functionalities.
